### Set up for the EARTHfest Evening Session:

- As people arrive they are given an agenda, with the Earth Promise on the other side. Chairs are set up in rows. There is a CD playing of Nature Sounds.
- There is a large poster/banner with “EARTHfest “ printed on it
- Cider is available on tables with cups and ladles
- At approximately 7:00 Muriel and Angela greet the audience with a brief explanation of the background, and the agenda for the evening.
- Maria Recchia is introduced and presents her workshop on the Wheel of the Year.
- Maria is thanked and people are asked to move to the back room, for a Drumming Circle experience. The back room is set up with chairs in a circle, and drums and rattles on each chair.
- Following the Drumming, people are then asked to move to the front room for the Poetry slam. The front room is still set up with chairs in rows for the Poetry slam. Three local poets perform their Earth focused poetry .
- Following the Poetry Slam, people are asked to move their chairs into a large circle for the guided Meditation.
- Following the Meditation, the Earth Promise will be made.
- People will be thanked for their participation and the event will close.
